

# WINTERIZING CHECKLIST

"Use this as a winterizing guide for your boat"

## FRESH WATER, SALT WATER, AIR CONDITIONING & SANITATION SYSTEMS

- Empty Water Tanks, Drain Hot Water Heater & Install Bypass
- □ Run Marine NON-Toxic Antifreeze (-50° or -100°) through lines
- Pump Out Head & Holding Tank then Winterize Head & Holding Tank with Marine NON-Toxic Antifreeze (-50° or -100°)
- □ Winterize Salt Water Washdown & Air Conditioning Pumps
- Run Marine NON-Toxic Antifreeze (-50° or -100°) through entire system

### **INBOARD & OUTBOARD FOUR-STROKE ENGINES**

- □ Treat Fuel with Conditioners & Run through System
- □ Change Engine Oil
- □ Change Air, Fuel & Oil Filters
- □ Check Closed Coolant system & Add Coolant If Needed
- □ Replace Engine Aluminum or Zinc Anodes as Needed
- □ Pump Marine NON-Toxic Antifreeze (-50° or -100°) through Raw Water System
- □ Fog Engine with Marvel Mystery Oil (Sterndrive or Inboard)
- □ Fog Engine with Fogging Fluid (Two-Stroke Models) or Winter Mix Fuel as Per Manufacturer Recommendation (Four-Stroke Models)
- Coat Engine or Powerhead with Rust Inhibitor
- □ Inspect Engine Control Cables, Replace as needed

## **OUTDRIVES & OUTBOARD LOWER UNITS**

- Change Lower Unit Oil, Replace Drain Screw Seals and Gaskets
- □ Grease Fittings
- □ Remove Prop and grease prop Shaft
- □ Change Water Pump Impeller as Needed
- □ Replace Outdrive, transom and lower Unit Aluminum or Zinc Anodes as Needed
- □ Inspect Shift and Exhaust Bellows, Replace as Needed
- Inspect Shifter Cable, Replace as Needed

#### BATTERIES

- □ Remove and Check Battery Function
- □ Charge and then Store in a Cool and Dry Place
- □ Clean ALL Terminals and Coat in a Corrosion Inhibitor
